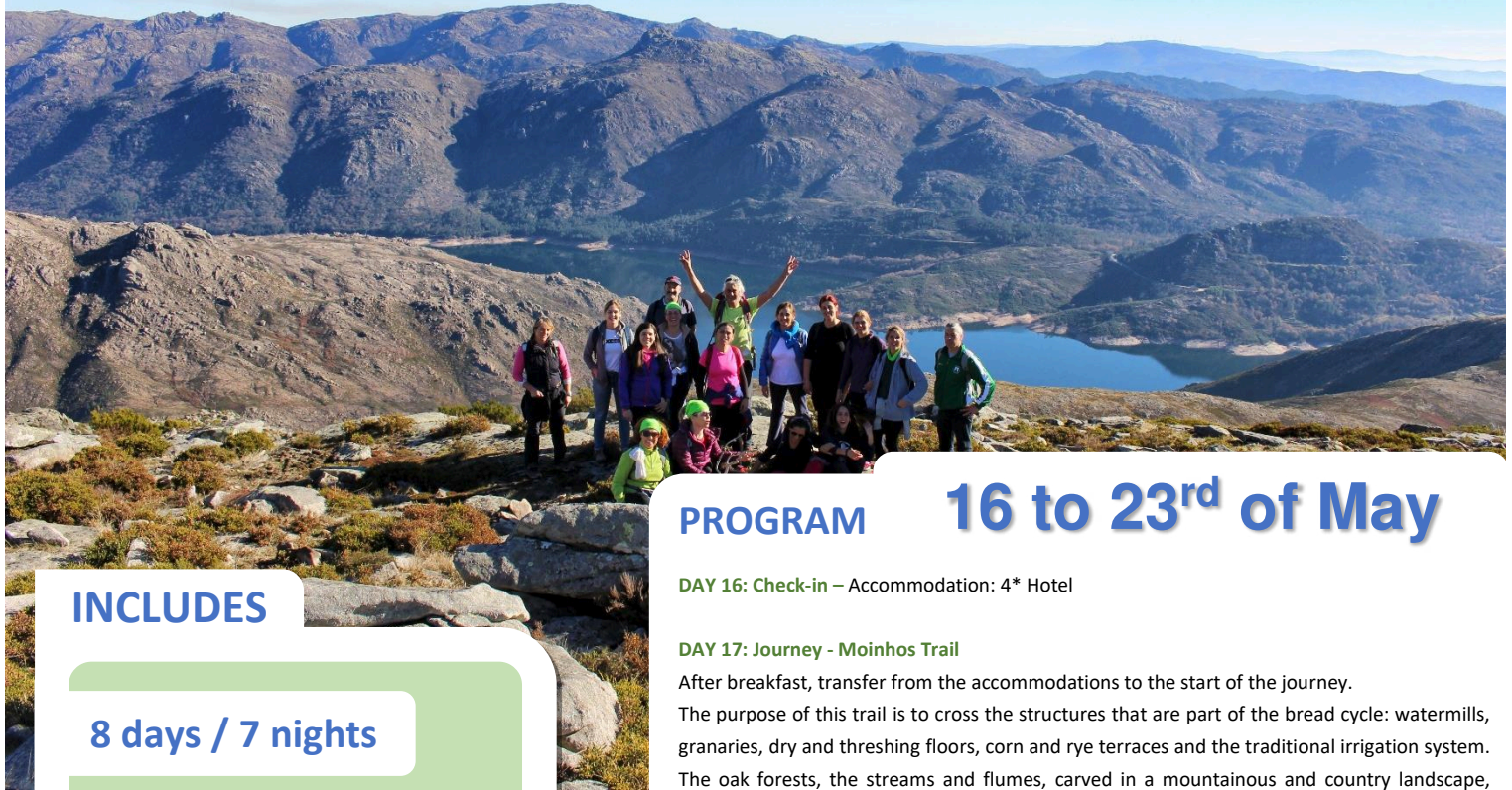


# WALKING TRAILS IN GERÊS

The Peneda-Gerês National Park (PNPG) covers the territories of Arcos de Valdevez, Melgaço, Montalegre, Ponte da Barca and Terras do Bouro. Being the Country, this protected area is considered by UNESCO as a World Biosphere Reserve, it's one of the biggest natural attractions of Portugal due to the rare beauty of the landscape and the variety of fauna and flora.

## PROGRAM 16 to 23<sup>rd</sup> of May

**DAY 16: Check-in** – Accommodation: 4\* Hotel

### DAY 17: Journey - Moinhos Trail

After breakfast, transfer from the accommodations to the start of the journey.

The purpose of this trail is to cross the structures that are part of the bread cycle: watermills, granaries, dry and threshing floors, corn and rye terraces and the traditional irrigation system. The oak forests, the streams and flumes, carved in a mountainous and country landscape, grants the trail a rural value of true excellency. Transfer to accommodations: 4\* Hotel

### DAY 18: Journey - Calcedónia Trail

After breakfast, transfer from the accommodations to start the journey.

This trail takes place in the territories of Covide and Campo do Gerês, which represent an important historical-cultural plot, thanks to its community traditions and archaeological antiques. This circular trail will reach the mythical archaeological site named "Fraga da Cidade", that the old ones have immortalized with the classic name of Calcedónia.

Transfer to accommodations: 4\* Hotel

### DAY 19: Journey - Pé de Cabril Trail

After breakfast, transfer from the accommodations to start the journey.

This trail starts in the ancient Forest Guard House of Junceda, at the heart of Gerês. Pé de Cabril it's a mountain top in the Serra do Gerês, in the municipality of Terras do Bouro. This peak is one of the most visible and most easily recognizable to whoever observes it from the Gerês mountain. Transfer to accommodations: 4\* Hotel

**DAY 20: Free day** - Accommodations: 4\* Hotel

### DAY 21: Journey - Geira Trail

After breakfast, transfer from the accommodations to start the journey.

The Geira trail follows the Roman road that connected Braga to Astorga through kilometres – Roman miles actually. An amazing engineering feat, built two thousand years ago, it still follows the traces through the same curve level, which make it easier for the traveller. In lots of sections, the oak trees, moss and sidewalks create a scenery of excellency.

Transfer to accommodations: 4\* Hotel

### DAY 22: Journey - Albergaria trail

After breakfast, transfer from the accommodations to start the journey.

The Mata de Albergaria is one of the most important forests of the Peneda-Gerês National Park. Constituted predominantly by secular oak trees, includes characteristic species of the fauna and flora of Gerês. It has also a section of the Roman road - Geira - with the ruins of its bridges and a significant set of milestones. Transfer to accommodations: 4\* Hotel
